



#### **ACTION STEP 1: Record a 3-minute video of yourself explaining a topic.**

- Choose a topic from all the things you are teaching.
- Make an outline of what you want to cover in the video (I suggest you to only have an outline, not a script to sound more natural.)
- Set up your cell phone camera.
- Hit record and get started.
- Talk into the camera as if students were there!
- Have fun and send it to your students!
- Don't worry about the memes or stickers your students might make. Think about the students that will benefit from it.

#### **ACTION STEP 2: Use graphic organizers to use the thinking routines more easily.**



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### **ACTION STEP 3: Implement cooperative learning strategies.**
