ORIENTACIONES PARA LOS PADRES DE FAMILIA

Esta guía de aprendizaje de inglés para el trabajo en casa tiene como finalidad ayudar a su hijo a practicar vocabulario sobre las rutinas diarias y a aprender cómo expresar su rutina cotidiana con oraciones simples. Su hijo (a) deberá dedicar una hora para desarrollar toda la guía. El trabajo se relaciona con la página 20 del libro del estudiante Way to Go 6, que se adjunta al final de esta Guía.

- ✓ La actividad 1 Consiste en ver un video sobre una rutina diaria y responder preguntas acerca del mismo.
- ✓ La actividad 2 Invita a comprender y completar frases relacionadas con actividades que hacemos diariamente para familiarizarse con este vocabulario.
- ✓ La actividad 3 consiste en leer y completar una simple encuesta sobre actividades cotidianas para reforzar el vocabulario de la actividad anterior.
- ✓ La actividad 4 le ayuda a su hijo(a) a descubrir aspectos gramaticales relacionados con el tiempo presente simple para describir las actividades diarias.
- ✓ La actividad 5 se relaciona con el ejercicio 2 de la página 20 del libro Way to Go 6; éste consiste en escuchar la pista 11 (track 11) para completar los espacios del párrafo con las palabras del cuadro.
- ✓ La actividad 6 invita a describir su rutina diaria a través de oraciones simples utilizando el vocabulario y la gramática trabajada en los puntos anteriores.
- ✓ Por último, la actividad 7 es para que su hijo(a) autoevalúe lo aprendido.

Además, pueden encontrar ejemplos de respuesta de las actividades resaltadas en amarillo, las respuestas correctas y recursos adicionales de apoyo. Agradecemos su colaboración supervisando que su hijo(a) complete las actividades indicadas. Al final, ustedes encontrarán una serie de preguntas de verificación de lo que su hijo(a) aprendió mediante el desarrollo de esta guía.

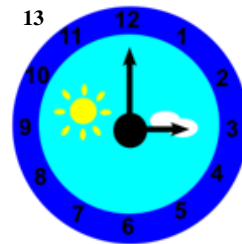
